WEBB'S ABOUT TOWN

Adam's Single Malt Whisky, Old Kempton Apple Liqueur, Lillet Blanc

An entrepreneurial, former-convict and talented confectioner who owned the hotel in the mid-1800s. Webb introduced many innovations to the hotel, including Tasmania's first ice creams in 1850 and Tasmania's first roller skating rink in 1867.



ETHEL'S ANTIDOTE

Spiced Rum, Lemon, Honey, Wattle

Described as 'every digger's sweetheart', Ethel Campbell MBE became beloved for meeting and farewelling troops during the first world war. When she visited Hobart in 1923, she was taken to Hadley's in a car drawn by cheering returned soldiers.



AMUNDSEN'S FROST

Coconut Rum, Alize, Cream, Lime, Pineapple

A daring Norwegian explorer who stayed at Hadley's direct from discovering the South Pole. When his achievement became known, congratulatory telegrams poured in. Tasmanian journalists were so desperate for an interview they tried to break down the door of his hotel room!

NIGHTINGALE'S LEMONADE

Charles Reuben Grapefruit Vodka, Elderflower Liqueur, Lime, Elderflower Syrup, Butterfly Pea Flower, Lemonade

As the first Tasmanian to achieve international success in the arts, soprano Amy Sherwin drew a large crowd when staying and performing at Hadley's in 1887.



GRACE'S CHASE

Hadley's x Captain Bligh's Oriental Expression Gin, Lime, Mint

A legendary sportsman, known for his cricketing prowess. Hadley's was the headquarters for Grace and the English cricket team when they visited in 1882.



MARY'S MULBERRY SOUR

Mulberry Sloe Gin, Raspberry Liqueur, Vanilla, Lemon, Egg White

The pioneering first female licensee of Hadley's Orient Hotel. Her leadership and management skills were instrumental in establishing the hotel's reputation for elegance and quality service in the late 19th century.



PORTER'S LAST WORD

Charles Reuben Grapefruit Vodka, Green Chartreuse, Maraschino Liqueur, Lime

Known for his vivid storytelling and autobiographical works, the acclaimed Australian writer was a habitué of Hadley's bar.



MAWSON'S MARTINEZ

7K Aqua Vita Gin, 7K Raspberry Gin, 7K Sweet Vermouth, 7K Bitters, Lemon

Renowned geologist and explorer who met the members of his Australasian Antarctic Expedition 1911-14 over lunch at Hadley's in 1911, marking the first opportunity for Mawson to meet those who had journeyed to join the remarkable venture.
